

Spa Care Guide

Relax into clean & clear spa water with Leisure Time™

Care for the spa that cares for you

Ensure your spa water is always clean, healthy and ready for relaxation with this quick reference quide.

Ideal chemical levels:

pH 7.2 - 7.8

Total Alkalinity: 80 - 120 ppm

Calcium Hardness:

150 - 400 ppm

Chlorine: 2 – 3 ppm

Bromine: 2 – 4 ppm

Before handling spa chemicals:

Always read and follow all product labels.

Add chemicals directly to spa water with pump running.

Never mix chemicals.

Remember to











Always read product label directions and use only as directed

Always add chemicals to spa water, never the other way around

Never add chemicals to spa water when people are in the spa

Never mix products together

Always store spa products in a cool, dry location and away from direct sunlight



Always wear proper safety equipment when handling chemicals

Easy spa maintenance routine

Follow these guidelines to maintain clean, healthy and relaxation-ready spa water.

Weekly

Steps

Test and balance spa water 2 - 3 times per week Shock spa water & eliminate contaminants

Protect spa surfaces, prevent staining & eliminate scum lines

Monthly

Steps

Get professional water testing

Clean the filter

Inspect the spa cover
— check for cracks,
warping, broken stitching
& replace as needed

Check with your local retailer for onsite water testing services





Quarterly

Clean & condition your spa cover to repel dust, dirt & water & add UV protection

Drain and refill spa with clear plumbing lines


Deep-clean the filter overnight

Yearly

Steps	Replace filter cartridges to ensure effective spa water filtration	Inspect spa cabinet — look for any signs of damage from water leaks, pests or electrical issues
Recommended Products/ Services	Purchase filter cartridges specific to your spa's make and model	Lubricate O-rings and gaskets per manufacturer's recommendations
